We are looking for a cook whose experience allows them to jump in and continue to coach our members on best work practices.

ESSENTIAL ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Cook foodstuffs according to menus, special dietary or nutritional restrictions, or numbers of portions to be served
- Monitor food services operations to ensure procedures are followed
- Clean food preparation areas, facilities, and equipment
- Direct activities of one or more working members who assist in preparing meals
- Train new members who begin employment
- Other duties as assigned
- Compile and maintain accurate records of food use and expenditures
- Take inventory of supplies and equipment
- Complete time trials and reports within the required time

- Minimum one year experience cooking in an institutional kitchen
- Experience coaching staff or members on best cooking practices/safety
- Experience working with people with intellectual and developmental disabilities
- Team player who will collaborate with existing staff
