Under the general direction and supervision of the DTA Program Manager, the Media Instructor is responsible for the coordination and implementation of the Media program's daily operations at Civitan's Village.

General Duties & Responsibilities:

- Develops a media curriculum that teaches members skills in a variety of areas including but not limited to audio, video, photography, graphic design, and basic computer programs and hardware.
- Demonstrates mastery of subject matter, instructional skills, and resource materials for curriculum taught.
- Creates and implements weekly lesson plans.

- Employs a variety of teaching strategies and adapts lessons to meet the individual needs and learning styles of class members.
- Teaches and emphasizes internet and social media safety.
- Utilizes available technology and instructional media to enhance member learning experiences.
- Identifies and applies adaptive technologies that meet member needs and enhance program objectives.
- Maintains a safe, organized classroom, which supports member learning and promotes individual choice, freedom, and personal responsibility.
- Fosters a learning environment that encourages lifelong learning.
- Acts as an appropriate role model and supports people in using appropriate language, dress, manners, and respect.
- Collaborates with other Village Specials Instructors.
